

# "CAMERA IN A BOX"

Hello! The thing you just found is called "CAMERA IN A BOX"!  
If you want to know what it is, read the following instructions for use:

- (1) Take the camera out of the box and take a picture of any subject, that has attracted your attention. You might choose something you really like or something you doesn't like at all. You can take a picture of yourself, of a friend, of your favourite place to be - it's up to you. Choose something you would like show to other people, something that you would like to share!
- (2) If you would like to give any explanation on the picture, you can use the notebook which is to be found in the box as well. Please write down your name (it doesn't necessarily need to be your real name - you can make one up) and explain what could be seen on the picture and why you have chosen this subject.  
If you would like to keep this private, then you don't need to write down anything!
- (3) Once you have taken the picture, please put the camera, the notebook, the pen and this instruction sheet back into the box! And please make sure that the postpaid envelop is still in the box.
- (4) Take the box with you, and on your way, leave it on some location which is accessible to others. Now the „CAMERA IN A BOX“ will be found by some one else and the process will start over again.

**The idea of „CAMERA IN A BOX“ will unfold at it's best, if you stick to these rules:**

- Please take only one picture.
- Please make sure that the box is kept dry. Leave it on a place where it is easily accessible to others.
- Please don't carry the box across the national border, since the stamps are only valid within Germany.

## **Have you taken the last picture?**

In case the photo film inside the camera is full or you have taken the last picture, kindly put the camera and the notebook into the prepaid envelope provided in the box and mail to the address which is written on the envelope.

As soon as the camera is retrieved, the film will be developed and the pictures will be posted in the internet - check [www.camerainabox.blogger.de!](http://www.camerainabox.blogger.de)

We would request you to email us (if you can) on [camerainabox@googlemail.com](mailto:camerainabox@googlemail.com) and mention the location on which the camera was left/found by you. This will enable us to trace the camera's journey which will also be mentioned on our blog.
